

Autumn Term Curriculum

This term's class text is 'Harry Potter and the Philosopher's Stone.' We will be using this book to inspire our writing in English lessons. Get your wizardry skills ready! We will also be linking our history work to our writing when we become Lindisfarne monks and decide 'should we stay or should we go?' when the Vikings attack our monastery.

In science, we will be learning about states of matter looking at the properties of solids, liquids and gases and how this relates to the water cycle. This is closely linked to our geography work.

Let's travel back in time to AD 450, when the Anglo Saxons settled in Britain. We will discover how they lived and changed the way we live today. What was life like for them? Then, enter the Vikings—raiders or traders? This will be our Autumn 2 history unit.

In art and DT we will look at the work of Frida Kahlo and use her pieces to inspire us to create work of our own. We will also be creating Anglo Saxon houses with framed wooden structures, which would be typically found in settlements of the time.

The children in Year 4 are privileged to learn the ukulele. Over the year, they will have the exciting opportunity to have weekly lessons with a music specialist, which will culminate in an end of year musical showcase.





Reminders:

<u>P.E:</u> This will take place twice weekly. Please ensure your child comes to school in their PE kit on Wednesday & Thursdays.
