## Forest School – Starts back week beginning 15th January

On your child's Forest school day please send a named bag containing, wellies, waterproof jacket and trousers. This kit is likely to get very dirty so a plastic/ washable bag is best.

As the weather is getting colder we ask you make sure your child is dressed that day in either trousers or warm tights. If your child is in tights please send legging or jogging to put on over the top.

You can also send gloves and hat but please be aware these will get muddy!

Even if it is a sunny day please send full kit as children will have access mud kitchens and messy tasks in all weathers.

As part of our risk assessment for some of the activities available to the children during Forest school, such as, tree climbing and rope swings all earing must be removed. Staff cannot not assist with this.

We do Forest School whatever the weather!

# <u>PE</u>

Please send your child in their PE kits on their PE day. Trainers are fine to be worn on PE days. Earing needs to be removed on PE days. Staff cannot assist with this.

## <u>Reading</u>

Children will read daily as part of their RML phonics session they will also be heard read individually with the teacher at least once a fortnight.

Books will be changed weekly on a Friday.

We recommend you read with your child 5 times a week so they build up confidence and fluency.

We will be putting our reading book library out at the end of the day outside RKV. You can borrow extra reading books from here. These are not part of our school reading scheme but can be used to support your child's reading progress.

Also in your child's reading folder is a list of 'red' words that we would like your children to learn to read by sight. You cannot sound out a red word so the children need to recognise them by sight. By being able to recognise and speedily read these words their fluency and understanding progresses much quicker.

## <u>Class Dojo</u>

Please regularly check on Class Dojo. We post weekly updates on what the children have been doing in school and also reminder messages. You can also use the App to message us any questions. Please still contact the school office to report absences.

### Bits and Bobs donation
