### **Curriculum:**

<b>History</b>	Local history study of the Battle of Bosworth. This will include knowing who took part in the battle and why, who won and the consequences for British history. We will go on the look at the role of heritage societies in preserving history for the future.
<b>Design and Technology</b>	The children will be investigating different types of bread, how to knead dough, how yeast works and designing their own unique flavours for a bread roll.
<b>R. E</b>	Christians and how to live: what would Jesus do? This unit looks at teaching of the Gospel and this impacts today.
<b>French</b>	Habitats: Children will learn how to express in the foreign language the essential elements that all plants and animals need to survive.
<b>P. E</b>	Outdoor: Athletics Indoor: dance
<b>Science</b>	Animals including humans This unit will focus on how humans change throughout their lives. This will include: how babies develop in the womb, the human lives have different phases of development, how people change when in old age and the gestation period. <i>Please not that we will cover changes during puberty in the second half term and we will send more information about this in due course.</i>
<b>PSHE</b>	Relationships: Focusses on creating and maintaining positive relationships with friends and family members.
