Curriculum Committee
Terms of Reference 2025-2026

Membership

- The committee shall consist of at least 4 governors of whom one is the Head Teacher.
- Committee membership shall be determined at the annual Strategy Day in the Autumn Term.
- The committee may have additional members who support the activity but who do not participate in any voting.
- There will be a chair for these meetings agreed by the membership annually.

Quorum

- The committee meeting can only function if there is a minimum of 3 members present.

Meetings

- The committee shall meet 3 times a year, and otherwise as necessary.
- In the absence of the chair, the committee shall choose an acting chair for that meeting from among their number.

Review

- These Terms of Reference will be reviewed annually at the Strategy Day in the Autumn Term unless there are significant changes in which case it will be reviewed at the first Full Governors Meeting in the Autumn Term.

Purpose

The committee will:

- Review the intent of the curriculum offered in school, to ensure it is ambitious, broad and balanced.
- Ensure that [statutory requirements](#) are met in the design of the curriculum.
- Ensure the curriculum design meets the needs of all learners and enables all to fulfill their potential.
- Monitor and evaluate the implementation of the curriculum offered in school, to ensure that progress is made towards the school's priority objectives as set out in the BBPIP.
- Monitor and evaluate the impact of the curriculum offered in school in terms of pupil attainment and progress, to ensure the school's priority objectives as set out in the BBPIP are met.
- Monitor and evaluate the effectiveness of active learning (through the Learning Power Approach) in enabling all learners to be successful.
- Monitor and review the progress and attainment of all pupils, including disadvantaged pupils and those with SEND.
- Ensure that the views of key stakeholder groups such as pupils and parents are taken into consideration when monitoring the impact of the curriculum.
- Consider recommendations related to the curriculum from external sources and ensure an appropriate plan is in place to act on these.
- Review and monitor any policies delegated by the Full Governing Board.
