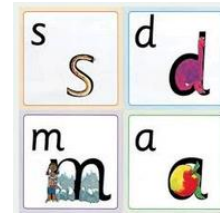


## RML sounds



## Set 1 Sounds

These sounds are what we call 'pure sounds'. For example we would pronounce 'm' as 'mmm' rather than 'muh'. We teach these sounds in the following order:

m a s t d i n p g o c k u b f e l h sh r j v y w th  
z ch qu x ng nk

## Set 2 Sounds

There are 12 set 2 sounds. Below are a list of these sounds and the little saying that help the children to remember them.



ay – may I play?

ee- what can you see?

igh- fly high

ow- blow the snow

oo- poo at the zoo

oo- look at a book

ar- start the car

or- shut the door

air- that's not fair!

ir- whirl and twirl

ou- shout it out!

oy- toy for a boy

### Set 3 Sounds



*a-e- make a cake*

*ai- snail in the rain*

*ea- cup of tea*

*i-e- nice smile*

*o-e- phone home*

*oa- goat in a boat*

*u-e- huge brute*

*ew- chew the stew*

*aw- yawn at dawn*

*are- care and share*

*ur- nurse with a purse*

*er- a better letter*

*ow- brown cow*

*oi- spoil the boy*

*ire- fire! fire!*

*ear- hear with your ear*

*ure- sure it's pure*

*We encourage the children to use these sounds when reading and spelling, you might notice children sounding out words on their 'Fred Fingers' when writing for their homework!*
